**Beginners Shows** are open to anyone eligible for KC grade 1 or handlers from higher grades with new dogs that have not been placed in the top 10 at KC shows. Handlers may carry a toy but the toy must not be thrown to accelerate the dog. Dogs may compete at one height below that for which they are eligible. Weaves will not be marked but must be completed correctly. There are 5 possible jump heights: Micro, Small, Medium, Standard, Large. Limited to 300 runs. Class 1: Agility 1 – no weaves, no seesaw, Class 2: Agility 2 – all equipment, Class 3: jumping - Jumps, weaves and tunnels, Class 4: Steeplechase – Just jumps and tunnels.

**Winter Series** for dogs in KC grades 1-5. The categories are:

Small Grades 1-5

Medium Grades 1-5

Standard/Large Grades 1-2

Standard/Large Grades 3-5

The four shows are run as a tournament. Points will be awarded for places in each class at each show. At the last show trophies will be awarded to the dogs with the most points in each of the four categories. Limited to 500 runs.

**Gold Rush 1-7** shows are open to everyone although the courses will be aimed at the higher grades so this is your chance to try a more challenging course. Categories are Small, Medium, Standard/Large. At each individual show the results of the Jumping and Steeplechase classes will be combined using the same points system as the Winter Series and the overall winning dog from each category will receive prize money based on the number of entries in the show eg if there are 100 dogs entered the winning dogs will receive a share of £50 if there are 50 dogs entered £25 minimum prize money £10. In the event of a tie the Agility results will be used. Limited to 500 runs.

The courses will be the same for all heights and there will only be one opportunity to walk the course.

Jump heights are micro (beginners shows only), small, medium, standard and large using the Kennel Club measuring system. Any dog may compete at standard height at all of our shows this is to encourage young dogs and allow older dogs to compete more comfortably. At all shows you may compete at a lower jump height than that for which your dog is eligible eg large dogs can run over small or medium jumps for clear round rosettes only. (Beginners shows 2 jump heights lower).

There will be two rings – one indoors and one outdoors on an allweather surface. If the weather is bad we will run the whole show in the indoor ring. In case of bad weather please check the website: [www.pachesham-agility.com](http://www.pachesham-agility.com) for information.

Rosettes will be presented to at least 10% and prizes to 3<sup>rd</sup> in each category in each class, at beginners shows the micro and small heights will count as one category, at all shows the standard and large heights will count as one category but if entries are large enough we will split them and give rosettes and trophies to each jump height. Clear round rosettes are available for all classes at the beginners shows and for all classes except the steeplechase at the other shows..

Entries can be booked by email but payment must be received within 7 days or the entry will be cancelled.

Entries close 2 weeks before the date of the show after which no refunds or exchanges to other shows can be made. However, late entries may be accepted on the day if the limit has not been reached but you must phone in advance, do not just turn up on the day.

Dogs must be at least 16 months old on the day of the show to compete. 18 months for 1-7.

No bitches in season.

Training rounds are permitted. You will be allowed a standard course time of 60 seconds and you may not use food. Please inform the Scrimmer if you wish to train.

Anyone considered to be harsh handling will be asked to leave. Spray collars and pet correctors are not permitted.

Please do not use squeaky toys near the rings although you may use one in the ring if you are training. You can carry a squeaky toy in a beginners show but not squeak it unless you wish to run NFC (not for competition).

Running orders will be sent out by email a week before the show and will be available to be viewed on the day.

Dogs must be kept on lead at all times when not competing unless exercising in the woods. Please respect the venue and the horses and please pick up after your dogs even in the woods and use the bins provided.

These are fun shows. Timing is manual.

## **WINTER SERIES TOURNAMENT POINTS**

Points will be awarded as follows for places in each category (small, medium, standard/large 1-2, standard/large 3-5 at each show. At the last show trophies will be awarded to the dogs with the most points in each category.

1<sup>st</sup> 20 points, 2<sup>nd</sup> 19 points, 3<sup>rd</sup> 18 points, 4<sup>th</sup> 17 points, 5<sup>th</sup> 16 points, 6<sup>th</sup> 15 points. Unplaced clear rounds will receive 10 points. Points tables will appear on the website after each show.

## **REFRESHMENTS**

## **DIRECTIONS**

Pachesham Equestrian Centre (KT22 0AL) is situated on the A245, Randalls Road, nearly 1 mile from Leatherhead railway station in the direction of Cobham on the right hand side. From the **M25 J9** follow signs to Esher (A244). At the first small roundabout turn left into Oaklawn Road, signposted "Crematorium, Golf Centre", at the end of Oaklawn Road turn left onto the A245 towards Leatherhead. We are the first property on the left. From the **A3** leave at the "Esher Common" junction (A244). Follow the A244 towards Leatherhead. Go approximately 2.5 miles through Oxshott. At the roundabout turn left into Oaklawn Road – see above. Please park only in the car parks – there is one at the top of the drive and one outside the indoor school – the speed limit is 5mph once you have entered the property. Please always shut the entrance gate behind you.
