Pachesham Covid Compliant Shows 2020

This is a universal schedule, only the dates will change and these can be found on the website.

1-3 Shows

For dogs in grades 1-3, max. 6 weaves, no seesaw Classes: Jumping, Agility, Steeplechase

1-7 Shows

Open to all, all equipment used, more challenging courses Classes: Agility 1, Jumping, Agility 2

at Pachesham Equestrian Centre, Randalls Road, Leatherhead, Surrey KT22 OAL Entry fees are £12 per dog, you cannot enter individual classes.

Each show closes 2 weeks before the competition after which no refunds or transfers can be made

COVID 19 Compliance Guidelines:

Upon arrival at the venue, we ask that all visitors use either gloves or hand sanitizer when opening and closing the Main Gate.

Handlers will be divided into groups of five, with a corresponding schedule and allotted time slot, which will be circulated prior to the show. These groups will walk courses, warm up, and queue together.

During breaks, we ask that handlers remain in their vehicles.

Parking will be arranged according to these groups, with accordance to social distancing rules.

Handlers that have more than one dog competing within the same height category will be assigned to two different groups, allowing time for change over and proper preparation.

There will be a designated exercise are, but we ask that handlers keep their dogs on lead and maintain social distancing.

Please do not touch any of the equipment or barrier fencing whilst on site. The show organisers will have their own measures in place to deal with movement around the venue as well as any handling of leads when courses are being run.

We also request that you do not bring any additional people to the show, as they will be asked to spend the entirety of the time within their vehicles, just yourself and dog(s). Please also refrain from spending any additional time on site outside of your allotted slot.

Toilets: We have exclusive use of a toilet, please use hand sanitizer before and after use.

1-3 Shows are open to any dog and handler combination who are eligible to compete in KC shows at grades 1, 2 and 3. These are independent shows, so your dog does not have to be KC registered or have been officially measured, the KC grades are just a guideline. **If you have never competed at any show before you are eligible for grade 1.**

Agility has no seesaw and a maximum of 6 weaves, Jumping has a maximum of 6 weaves, Steeplechase has just jumps and tunnels.

1-7 Shows are open to all and have more challenging courses. All equipment is used.

JUMP HEIGHTS: KC jump heights small - 30cm, medium - 40cm, intermediate - 50cm and large 60cm. We feel that with the new lower heights we do not need to offer the lower height option so from January 2020 this will no longer be available. If the results are combined for intermediate and large the LARGE dogs will be able to compete at intermediate height.

DOG HEIGHTS

SMALL - 35cm to the shoulder, jumps 30cm MEDIUM - 45cm to the shoulder, jumps 40cm INTERMEDIATE - 50cm to the shoulder, jumps 50cm LARGE - over 50cm at the shoulder, jumps 60cm

RULES and GENERAL INFORMATION

Competitors participate at their own risk.

The shows are all held at a working equestrian centre. Please keep your dog on the lead and pick up after it at all times. The stable yard is out of bounds. The speed limit once you enter the property is 5 mph that is very slow, less than walking speed anything faster is dangerous. Imagine if your dog slipped its collar when someone was driving too fast and do not do it! If you are caught speeding, you will be asked to leave!

All dog poo must be put in the bin near the rings.

Dogs must be at least 16 months to compete.

If you are doing a training round you will be allowed 60 seconds on the course. Please inform the scrimer if you wish to train.

No bitches in season.

Anyone considered to be harsh handling will be asked to leave.

Spray collars and pet correctors are not permitted.

If you have an aggressive dog please keep it away from the other dogs, if you let us know then we will make sure you do not miss your turn.

Please do not use squeaky toys near the ring although you may use one in the ring if you are training.

Jump heights are micro, small, medium, intermediate and large using the KC measuring system.

Beginners shows have rings which are fenced.

Courses are the same for all heights and may only be walked at the beginning, not between heights.

Rosettes will be presented to at least 10% and a trophy to the winner.

Depending on numbers intermediate/large results may be combined. Clear round rosettes are available in all classes.

Entries can be booked by using the online form on our website but payment must be received within 7 days or the entry will be cancelled.

Entries close 2 weeks before the date of the show after which no refunds or transfers to other shows can be made. However, if we have not reached our limit late entries will be accepted on the day although it is helpful to know the night before for the paperwork.

REFRESHMENTS: Due to current circumstances, we will not be offering refreshments, so please bring food and drink for yourself.

DIRECTIONS:

Pachesham Equestrian Centre (KT22 OAL) is situated on the A245, Randalls Road, nearly 1 mile from Leatherhead railway station in the direction of Cobham on the right hand side. From the M25 J9 follow signs to Esher (A244). At the first small roundabout turn left into Oaklawn Road, signposted "Crematorium, Golf Centre", at the end of Oaklawn Road turn left onto the A245 towards Leatherhead. We are the first property on the left. From the A3 leave at the "Esher Common" junction (A244). Follow the A244 towards Leatherhead. Go approximately 2.5 miles through Oxshott. At the roundabout turn left into Oaklawn Road – see above. The speed limit is 5mph once you have entered the property. Please always shut the entrance gate behind you. Parking is usually in the outdoor school which you will reach by driving VERY VERY SLOWLY round the edge of the property following the road. The postcode KT22 OAL will take you to Wildlife Aid which is a few 100 metres down the road. If Wildlife Aid is on your left turn round, we are the other side of the roundabout. If it is on your right keep going over the roundabout and you will find us on the right just after the tip.
